3.3. Immovable obstructions close to putting greens.

MLR F-5.2 is in effect modified in this way: For a ball at rest in the general area cut to fairway height or less, relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is (1) on the line of play (2) on or within two club-lengths of the putting green (3) within two club-lengths of the ball (4) is in an area cut to fairway height or less.

3.4. Removal of Temporary Water.

Model Local Rule J-2 is in effect and is modified in this way: If a player's ball lies on the putting green and there is interference by temporary water on the putting green, the player may:

- Take free relief under Rule 16.1d, or
- Have their line of play squeegeed.
- Have the putting green squeegeed when a ball lies adjacent to the putting green in any part of the course, but only when authorised by the Committee.

Such squeegeeing should be done across the line of play and extend a reasonable distance beyond the hole (that is, at least one roller length) and only be carried out by the Committee or someone authorised by the Committee. The Committee may squeegee the putting green between groups.

4. Animal not defined as loose impediment near ball

MLR E-13 is in effect. An animal not defined as a loose impediment may be removed. If the ball moves there is no penalty, and the ball must be replaced.

5. Integral objects

- Bunker liners in their intended position.
- Wires, cables, wrapping or other objects when closely attached to trees or other permanent objects.
- Artificial retaining walls and/or pilings when located within penalty areas.
- Artificial retaining walls and/or pilings when located on the edge of bunkers. These are not part of the bunker.

6. Ball deflected by permanent overhead power line.

MLR E-11 is in effect but only if it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball strikes a power line located in bounds and not the supporting pole/pylon. The player must replay the stroke (see Rule 14.6). If the player replays the stroke but does so from a wrong place, they get the general penalty under Rule 14.7. If the player does not replay the stroke, they get the general penalty and the stroke counts, but the player has not played from a wrong place.

7. Clubs and Balls.

- List of Conforming Driver Heads: MLR G-1 is in effect.
Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of this local rule: Disqualification.
- Groove and Punch Mark Specifications: MLR G-2 is in effect.
Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of this local rule: Disqualification.
- Conforming Balls List: MLR G-3 is in effect.
Penalty for making a stroke in breach of this local rule: Disqualification.

8. Restrictions on practice (Rule 5)

MLR I-1.1 and I-1.2 are in effect and Rule 5.2a and 5.2b are modified in this way: A player must not practice, roll a ball or rub the surface of the putting green on the competition course before or between rounds, but may practice on the designated practice areas.

Penalty for Breach of this Local Rule:

For first breach: General Penalty (applied to the player's first hole).

For second breach: Disqualification

9. Pace of Play Policy (Rule 5.6b (3))

A player, for whom it is possible to make a stroke and, from when it is deemed that he/she should have reached her/his ball, has

- 60 seconds to make the stroke if he/she is deemed to not have had time for preparing for her/his stroke
- 40 seconds to make the stroke if he/she is deemed to have had time for preparing to make her/his stroke

A player in breach of any of the time limits is deemed to have a "bad time".

Penalty for breach of this local rule during the same round:

One bad time	Verbal warning
Two bad times	Matchplay and strokeplay: One stroke penalty
Three bad times	Matchplay: Loss of hole; Strokeplay: Two stroke penalty
Four bad times	Disqualification

Notes:

- A player has had time to prepare for making her/his stroke if it is deemed that he/she should have reached his ball while,
 - another player in the same group, who is to make her/his stroke before the player, is preparing to make her/his stroke, or
 - the group in front of the player's group is within reach of the player's intended stroke.
- It is not possible to make a stroke when,
 - the group in front of the player's group is within reach of the player's intended stroke, or
 - the player's group has a ruling or is waiting for a referee, or
 - the player has to wait for players on holes close by.
- Players will not be advised that they are being timed.
- Players will not be timed on a hole where a match can be decided
- In case of a penalty the player should of be informed as soon as possible

10. Play suspensions (Rule 5.7)

MLR J-1 is in effect.

Immediate Stop/dangerous situation - one prolonged note of the siren.

Normal non-dangerous stop - three consecutive short notes of the siren.

Resume play - two consecutive short notes of the siren.

When play is suspended in a dangerous situation, all practice areas are immediately closed.

11. Transportation (Rule 4.3)

MLR G-6 is in effect. During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of transportation except as authorized by the Swedish Golf Federation.

Exception 1: Players born 1955 or earlier if authorized by their home club (applies only to a player who is a member of a Swedish golf club).

Exception 2: If a member of the committee at the competition in question temporarily gives permission to ride for a short distance.

Exception 3: A player taking a stroke and distance penalty is always authorized.

Note: Authorization is valid if; 1) the Committee assesses the condition of the course good enough to permit the use of transportation, and 2) the host club can provide transportation

Penalty for breach of this local rule:

General Penalty for each hole during which there is a breach. A breach between holes applies to the next hole.

12. Scoring in Stroke Play

MLR L-1 is in effect and modifies the penalty for a missing signature(s) under Rule 3.3b(2).
